Animal therapy refers to the contact with animals to help people get a good physical and mental health conditions and to improve quality of life. We have implemented a project to dispatch therapy dogs to facilities for children with disabilities, hoping that the relationship between children with disabilities and animals will have the effect of supporting the development of children with disabilities. As a result of analysis by expert team, many desirable behaviors and facility acceptance method were identified. We continue to work to promote the spread of animal therapy.
